## 2008 Summer Youth & Adult Programs

### INSURANCE REQUIRED FOR EXTERNAL, NON-AFFILIATED ORGANIZATIONS PRESENTING PROGRAMS ON CAMPUS AND/OR CONTRACTING FOR UNIVERSITY HOUSING

**At least forty-five (45) days before the Arrival Date**, Organization shall provide University with a certificate of insurance evidencing insurance coverage indicated below: The Organization shall maintain a policy of Commercial General Liability Insurance (including coverage for personal injuries) with a minimum limit of \$1,000,000 per occurrence; \$1,000,000 legal liability to participants. Organizations operating sports camps shall provide \$5,000 medical expense coverage per participant.

Also, the Organization shall maintain Workers' compensation insurance in an amount equal to the statutory limits established by the State of Minnesota for any and all workers. Organizations operating sports camps shall also provide evidence of \$1,000,000 professional liability coverage for claims arising out of instructing, demonstrating or advising regarding the performance of sports.

All such insurance shall be written by insurance companies licensed and authorized to do business in the state of Minnesota and shall name the Regents of the University of Minnesota as certificate holder and additional insured, and shall provide that such insurance shall not be cancelled or modified except upon at least thirty (30) days notice to the University. The Organization shall maintain the insurance described above on this page for the entire term of the agreement with the University.

The Organization may need to provide copies of the above insurance policies if requested by the University.
